## *250 years of jewelry*

### Inventors, patents and machines

Jewelry making techniques and jewelry styles for the past 250 years will be taught by veteran Collector's Conference speaker Christie Romero at the first Jewelry History course ever to be offered at Revere Academy in San Francisco.

The two-day workshop, taught by the well-known gemologist, lecturer and author, will be held on April 16th and 17th as part of the Revere Academy's 8th Annual Master's Symposium.

The Jewelry History workshop is geared toward makers, designers, collectors and

historians. The first day covers a timeline of jewelry-making techniques from ancient times to the present day, including metalsmithing, jewelry-related inventions, patents and machinery. Day Two presents an overview of jewelry styles, including the American Arts & Crafts movement. Both days include PowerPoint presentations and hands-on examples.
